



Bonding of Administrator for Adrian Gordy Estate

On 11 November 1715 Rosmon Corde (Gordy) accompanied by Ambrose Riggon appeared in court at Dividing Creek, Somerset County Maryland to post bond and receive her letter as administrator of the Estate of Adrian Corde (Gordy).

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Robson Esq Administrator of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of Bayan Esq Late of Somerset County deceased do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased Assessed in money and the same do made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the office for probat of wills &c. at or before the 10th day of March now next ensuing and the same goods Chattels and Credits do well and truly Administer viz do pay the debts of the said deceased which he did owe at the time of his decease so far forth as the said goods Chattels and Credits will extend and the Law will charge & further do make or cause to be made a true and just Account of and upon his ^{said} Administration within Twelve months from the day of his admittance to such Administration and such part or portion of ys goods as shall be found remaining upon ys Account examined and adjudged by the Judge appointed for the time being for probat of wills &c. distribute and dispose as by the said Judge shall be limited and appointed & lastly do at all and every time and times hereafter clearly acquit discharge and save harmless his sd Majesty his Judges and all other his officers and Ministers from all peidons having or pretending to have any right title or Interest of in to the said goods Chattels and Credits that then this present obligation to be void and of no effect otherwise to stand remain and be in full force power and virtue in Law.

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Rosmon Corde Administratrix of all and Singular the goods chattels and credits of Bryon Corde late of Somersett County deceased do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and Singular the goods chattels and credits of the said deceased appraised in money and the same so made do exhibit or cause to be Exhibited into the office for probate of wills ye at or before the 10th day of March now next ensuing and the same goods chattels and credits do well and truly Administer viz do pay the debts of the said deceased which he did owe at the time of his decease so far forth as the said goods chattels and credits will extend and the Law will charge & further do make or cause to be made a true and just account of and upon her said Administration within twelve months from the day of her admittance to such Administration and such part or portion of ye said goods as shall be found remaining upon ye said account examined and adjudged by the Judge Appointed for the time being for probat of wills “Ac:“ distribute and dispose as by the said Judge shall be limited and Appointed & lastly do at all and every June and Junes hereafter clearly acquit discharge and save harmless his said Majesty his Judges and all other his officers and Ministers from all persons having or pretending to have any right Title or Interest of in & to the said goods chattels and credits that then this present obligation to be void and of no effect otherwise to Stand remain and be in full force power and virtue in Law
