Moses Gordy repurchased "Winter Quarter" from Jeremiah Morris on 5 March 1743. The deed was recorded at the Worcester County Maryland Courthouse however the citation information was clipped from this copy.

by me said Thomas Hardy again. It John Nelson on the tenth day of
December 1743. before me for the sum of one pound and seven pence whole
Gold to be paid of your Good Land or Tenements for the use
of the said Thomas Hardy. the said sum of One pound and seven pence
whole Gold. and two Shilling and six pence paper money as aforesaid
Received against him with the additional Gold thereon. On the tenth
day of July next. Taken before me this 7 day of January 1743 -

This Indenture made the fifth Day of March in the Year of
our Lord One thousand seven Hundred forty and three. Between Jeremiah
Morris of Worcester County and and Lewis of Maryland Planter
of the one part and Moses Gordis of the same Place Planter of the other
part. Witnesseth that where as the said Jeremiah Morris doth
in consideration of the sum of forty pound Great money of Maryland to
him in hand paid by the said Moses Gordis before the Enrolling and delivery
of these presents the receipt where of the said Jeremiah Morris doth
truly Acknowledge and thereof and of every part and parcel thereof
doth fully Clearly and Absolutely Acquit Exonerate and discharge the said
Moses Gordis his heirs and Administrators family by these presents -
and for divers other good Causes and Considerations hereunto
expressed all given Granted Bargained sold Aligned Enticed conveyed and
conferred and by these presents doth give Grant Bargain sell Assignate
Confirm Convey and Confirm unto the said Moses Gordis his heirs and
Assigns for ever all that tract or parcel of Land Call'd and known by
the name of Winter Quarter Lying and being in Worcester County Original
granted unto the said Moses Gordis and patented to him for fifty Acres
to the same more or less. as by the Patent may more fully and at large
appear thereunto being had thereunto, and all and singular the Houses
Barns fences and other under woods to the same the joying and Belongings
and all Appurtenances and Reservations Remainders and Reservations, Right
Estate Interest Benefit Claim and Demand that is or shall be of him the said
Jeremiah Morris his heirs or Administrators and of his and to all and
singular the said Beneficiaries and of his and to all yearly and other rents
and profits thereunto appurtenant upon any Demise or lease of the said Premises.

or any part thereof to have and to hold the Land before mentioned and
 Intents to be hereby granted with these and Every of their appurtenances
 unto the said Moses Gordie his Heirs and Assigns for Ever to the only issue
 male and lawfull of him the said Moses Gordie his Heirs and Assigns for
 Evermore and the said Jeremiah Morris for himself and his Heirs the Land
 before mentioned Called Winter Quarters with the Appurtenances unto the said
 Moses Gordie his Heirs and Assigns against him the said Jeremiah Morris
 his Heirs and Administrators and against all and Every other person
 whatsoever Claiming any right title Interest Property or Demand whatsoever
 unto the Land before mentioned, or any part thereof from by or under
 him will warrant and by these presents for Ever hereafter Defend his
 Testimony whereof the said Jeremiah Morris hath hereunto set his Hand
 and fixed his Seal the day and year first above written

 Assembly in that behalf made and provided and the said Jeremiah Morris
 and his wife did both acknowledge the Land within mentioned
 Called Winter Quarters containing fifty Acres to be the right of the within
 mentioned Moses Gordie his Heirs and Assigns for Ever

 March the Sixth Day Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and
 forty three then was delivered unto me the Subscriber the within written
 Deed of Sale In order to be Enrolled amongst the records of Worcester
 County which said deed together with the Acknowledgment thereof
 thereon received were accordingly recorded amongst the same
 at the City of Boston the sixth day of March 1743
