



Survey of "Bushy Ridge" and "Range End" for Peter Gordy I

On 15 February 1754 Peter Gawdy received common warrants for "Bushy Ridge" and "Range End" each containing 50 acres and lying in Worcester County Maryland. On 15 April 1754 surveys were recorded together at Worcester County Courthouse. Each includes a survey description and plat. They are recorded on folio 100-101 but do not have the book information.

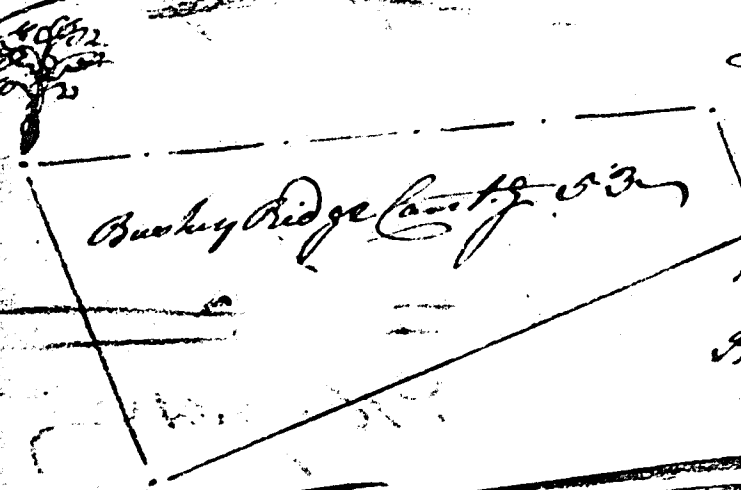

John Henry Dep: Surr: of Worcester County under the Hon:ble Com:rs: Taxers Sum: have seen and laid out for the said Samuel Hall all that Tract or parcel of Land called Bushey and situated lying and being in the County of Worcester as follows to wit: A marked White Oak standing on a Ridge on the North Side of a West line line running from Francis's Island to Chesapeake Bay about 30 yds from the said line on the North East Side of a Run called the Oceanus thence running N. 10 yds thence N. 150 yds thence South 30 yds thence with a right Line to the first Bounder containing and now laid out for 50: Acs of Land more or less to the Town of the Manour of Worcester
